Daily Schedule:

Daily Lunch, Snack and Drinks:

Drop-off & Pick-up:

Minnows will be housed in the "St. Theresa" building while Dolphins and Sharks will have their home-base in the new Activity Center. However, at some point during the summer, that parking lot will undergo renovations. During that time, students will need to enter through the front of the school at [700 Truman Ave](#). We will text message you those dates when they become available. A security gate code will be provided to you on the first day of camp.

TBS Summer Camp Checklist:

Please **label** and send these items with your child in a bag each day:

- snacks and drinks
- Bathing suit
- Towel
- Sunscreen
- *Minnows: A change of clothes sealed in a zip lock bag and **labeled**.

Important Things to Remember...

- Label all your child's belongings: bag, lunchbox, snack/lunch containers, water bottle, towel, sunscreen, clothing etc.
- Water bottles are necessary every day, especially for field trips.
- Parents must sign campers in/out daily with the counselors.
- Lunch and afternoon snacks are free!
- Send snacks/drinks for each day.
- The Camp Directory (located in front of The Activity Center & in front of St. Teresa's for PreK) will help you locate your child's group for drop-off and pick-up (remember to sign in/out).
- Campers attend field trips based on age and the discretion of the TBS Camp staff.
- Check the schedule for field trips to ensure your child is on time!
- Electronics are not allowed.
