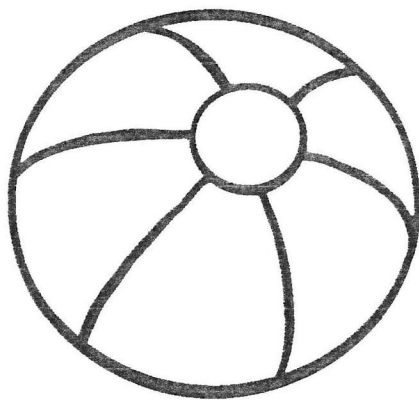
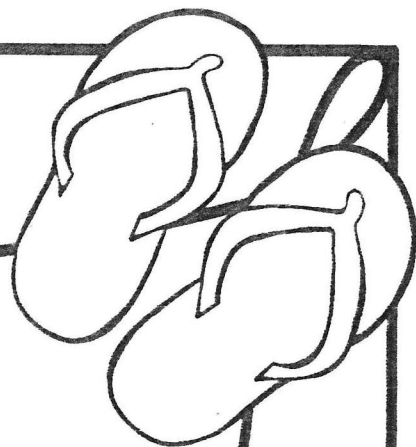

Dear Families,

I cannot wait to meet each one of the future Kindergarteners. The following are some things to review and practice this summer.

- ABC's: Talk about letters and letter sounds so that they are comfortable with them. We want them to be able to recognize their alphabet, both upper and lowercase. A few things to do to practice their handwriting is to write their name, mom, dad, their friend's names, and their sibling's names. You can begin by using a yellow or light colored marker to write the name or word they are wanting to write.
  - Math: Numbers! Most important are 1 -10. They should count them, recognize them, and write them.
- \*\* If driving a long distance you can always sing the alphabet or count to 100 (they will need to echo you to begin with)\*\*
- READ, READ, READ: Books have everything young minds need. They are full of letters and most books have numbers on each page. Use this time to draw their attention to the letters and numbers on the page. Supply ample paper, writing and coloring utensils. Ask them to write a letter, make a card, draw a picture, or even sit down to color together. You can even take a trip to the library to check out books together each week. There is a Summer Book Bingo sheet included that you can keep on your refrigerator to show off all the fun you have had reading.
  - Science: Cook with your student! Let them help you measure out ingredients then have them pour it in the bowl. Go on walks or to the beach and observe nature and wildlife. Talk about what you hear, see, smell, taste and touch.

I have included some pages to practice handwriting, letters, numbers and simple shapes. Also there is a page with educational websites to visit to practice their computer skills.

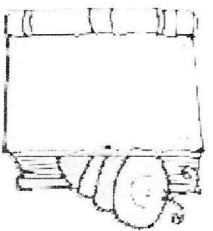

After reading these books to your child, have your child color the square or place a sticker over the square. Keep going until you fill the chart!

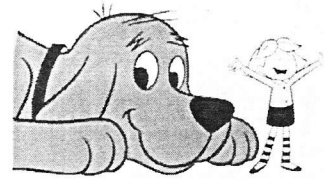
